



Article 01: Negotiate and Execute Tuition Contracts

To see if the School District will vote to authorize the School Board to negotiate and execute such tuition contracts as the Board may determine advisable for students inside or outside the Pemi-Baker Regional School District. The School Board recommends this article (Majority vote required.)

Article 02: Support Staff Collective Bargaining Agreement

To see if the School District will vote to approve the cost items included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the School Board and the Plymouth Regional Educational Association which calls for the following increases in salaries and benefits at the current staffing level:

Fiscal Year	Estimated Increase
2026-2027	\$299,542
2027-2028	\$328,060
2028-2029	\$306,474

And further to raise and appropriate Two Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Forty-Two Dollars (\$299,542) for the current fiscal year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits required by the new agreement over those that would be paid at current staffing levels. The School Board recommends this article (Majority vote required.)

Article 03: Fund Balance to Building Renovation Capital Reserve

To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) to be added to the Building Renovation Capital Reserve previously established. The sum to come from June 30 fund balance available for transfer on July 1. No amount to be raised from taxation. The School Board recommends this article (Majority vote required.)

Shall the Pemi-Baker Regional School District vote to raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling Nineteen Million, Fifty-Two Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-Nine Dollars (\$19,052,489)? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be Eighteen Million Eight Hundred Thirty-One Thousand Two Hundred Ninety-Three Dollars (\$18,831,293), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Pemi-Baker Regional School Board or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. This sum excludes the sum in Warrant Articles 2, 3, & 4. The School Board recommends this article. (Majority vote required.)
